





Framing lumber sales stalled in many species this week and price cuts grew, as there seemed to be more supply than demand. 2x6 # 2 & Btr showed the most decline in many species. Buyers sat on the sidelines this week causing SPF sales to slow. Mills that had tight supplies a week ago were reporting wide availability in some widths. As the start of the school year approaches, most buyers take a slower pace, which is typical for this time of year. OSB remains an issue, as there is just not enough supply out there, Plan ahead, as it seems like we won't see relief until early September.

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Roofing

Another month of mixed weather is affecting pricing and availability of roofing products. Hail, tornadoes, wind, heat and rain; we got it all this past month. All this is leading into the already announced price increases of asphalt roofing products for the first week of August. This will no doubt affect the current strained supply lines of products as well as extended lead times.

Lead times are, for most roofing products, 4-8 weeks or longer based on colors. Please contact your sales professional for more information.

Metal-roofing Manufacturers are running on standard lead times; 1-2 weeks on standard steel and 4-8 weeks on commercial lead times. Stock is in good shape and there are no increases for the near future.



Siding & Decking

Prices are stable at this time, with no new increases announced. Lead times are normal and stock is in good supply.



Insulation

Lead times on fiberglass blow-in insulation have grown a little this past month. We are currently at 3-4 weeks.

Fiberglass batt product lead times are moving as well at 2-3 weeks.

Insulation panels are in good supply and lead times are in the 1-2 week lead-time.

No price increases are expected in the near future for fiberglass or panels at this time.



Gypsum

No real change in the gypsum world at this time. Gypsum supply is good and lead times are in the 1-2-week period. Special order items will be at extended lead times. Please plan ahead on any larger projects you may have on the horizon.

One item to watch is the extended lead-time on Joint tapes. There seems to be a supply issue with this one particular item.

A significant portion or the price increase amounted to framing materials including trusses and engineered products.
